FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: FEMICIDE.

We refer to your email dated 18 April 2021 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on 19 April 2021.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

This is a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I would like a list provided to me of all cases of femicide recorded by your force in the past 3 years, starting April 2018 and ending April 2021. I would like you to provide details only in instances in which the force has designated the death as a "femicide".

Please provide the information in digital form, preferably in an excel spreadsheet.

I would like the case number for each instance, the name of the victim if possible, the date the femicide was committed and a note as to whether an individual has been held accountable by being charged and/or prosecuted.

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

The Ministry of Defence has Nil cases.

The Ministry of Defence Police (MDP) is a civilian Police force funded by the Ministry of Defence (MOD) to protect and secure key MOD assets. The MDP does not deal with this type of offence and any cases referred to them would be redirected to the relevant local Home Office Police Force or Police Scotland.
