JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The claim of race discrimination is dismissed upon withdrawal by the Claimant.
- 2. The reason for dismissal was conduct.
- 3. The dismissal was unfair as it fell outside of the range of reasonable responses in section 98(4).
- 4. The Claimant unreasonably failed to mitigate his losses. The period of loss is limited to 6 months following dismissal.
- 5. The Claimant's conduct contributed to his dismissal; the basic and compensatory awards will each be reduced by 60%.

6. Terms of settlement having been agreed between the parties, no further hearing is required.
