#### Introduction

The school improvement (SI) monitoring and brokering grant was announced on 30 November 2016. The grant has been allocated to local authorities since September 2017 to allow them to continue to monitor performance of maintained schools, broker school improvement provision, and intervene as appropriate. This document sets out allocations to cover the period September 2020 to March 2021. (As confirmed in the recent government response to our consultation on attaching conditions to the grant, this grant allocation round returns per school funding levels to those when the grant was established.)

#### Modelling

Please note that:

- funding is distributed to all eligible local authorities (excluding City of London and Isles of Scilly) to cover the period September 2021 to March 2022
- the minimum amount of funding a local authority can receive is £50,000 and all local authorities will receive at the least this amount in October 2021
- the allocations are made on a per eligible school basis for those schools deemed open on 1 September 2021:
  - eligible schools are schools run by local authorities, including special schools and PRUs, for pupils aged 5-16
  - the list used was extracted from Get Information About Schools (GIAS) as at September 2021
- the general labour market area cost adjustment (GLM ACA) factor is used matches the ACA used in the central school services block of the 2021 to 2022 national fnding formula.

#### Methodology

Please note that:

- for each local authority, the number of eligible schools was multiplied by its GLM ACA rate to calculate a weighted number of schools
- each local authorities' number of weighted eligible schools was multiplied by the weighted school funding unit of £1,996.55 to calculate the initial grant allocation – as per the per school funding levels when the grant was established

- the grant allocation for those local authorities falling below the minimum was increased to £50,000
- the grant allocations were rounded to the nearest pound to produce final figures
