How many people like myself have received another review in such a short time

How many People like my self have you contacted Universal Credit regarding their

claim"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

I would first like to apologise for the length of time it has taken to reply. Unfortunately, the Ministry of Defence requires further information in order to determine whether it holds any information within the scope of your request as it is not clear what information you are asking for. As such, please could you clarify if you are asking for:

- 1. The number of ALSO recipients who had their claims reviewed then reviewed again within a particular time period. (please specify between which dates).
- 2. How many ALSO reviews have required contact with Universal Credit as part of the review process? (please specify between which dates).

Once you have clarified your request, I will be happy to look at it again.
