JUDGMENT

It is the unanimous decision of the Employment Tribunal that:

- 1. the claimant was not unfairly dismissed under s103A of the Employment Rights Act 1996 ("ERA") but she was unfairly dismissed contrary to s94 of the ERA and that claim is upheld;
- 2. the claimant's claims for unlawful detriment under s47B of the ERA are not upheld and are dismissed.
- 3. the claimant's claims for unlawful direct discrimination because of race and/or religious belief (s13) and harassment related to race and/or religious belief (s26) and for victimisation (s27) under the Equality Act 2010 are not upheld and are dismissed.
