## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The first claimant, Ms Degbo:
  - a. suffered an unlawful deduction from wages in the sum of £4,016.26;
  - b. her itemised pay statements did not match the payments made to her and so there was a breach of her right under section 8 Employment Rights Act 1996 (ERA) to have itemised pay statements;
  - c. she was not provided with a statement of particulars of employment, contrary to sections 1 and 4 ERA, and a further sum of 4 weeks' pay, calculated on the basis of 40 hours per week at £10 per hour, is awarded, amounting to a further £1,600; and
  - d. accordingly the total sum due is £5,616.26
- 2. The second claimant, Mr Scarlett:
  - a. suffered an unlawful deduction from wages in the sum of £6,720;
  - b. his itemised pay statements did not match the payments made to him and so

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there was a breach of his right under section 8 Employment Rights Act 1996 (ERA) to have itemised pay statements;

- c. he was not provided with a statement of particulars of employment, contrary to sections 1 and 4 ERA, and a further sum of 4 weeks' pay, calculated on the basis of 40 hours per week at £10 per hour, is awarded, amounting to a further £1,600; and
- d. accordingly the total sum due is £8,320.00
