**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE:
CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFTS.**

We refer to your email dated 8 February 2020 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same date.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

“For each of the last five years, please provide the total number of crime logs or incident reports where there has been the theft of a catalytic converter from a vehicle.

For each of the last five years, please provide the total number of arrests on suspicion of theft or handing of a stolen catalytic converter from a vehicle.

For the last calendar year (1st January 2020 to 31st December 2020) please provide a breakdown of each incident - eg make or model of vehicle and, where available, the circumstances of the theft, eg owner's drive, street, locked premises.”

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
