EXPORT TO ITALY OF ANIMAL PRODUCTS OF TERRESTRIAL ANIMLAL FOR THE USE IN ARTIFICIAL BREEDING RESEARCH NOTES FOR GUIDANCE (NFG) FOR OFFICIAL VETERINARIANS AND EXPORTERS

This document should not be read as a standalone document but in conjunction with 9026EHC.

1. SCOPE OF THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be used for the export of animal products of terrestrial animals where the certification takes place in Wales, Scotland or England, i.e. in Great Britain, and the collection and handling of the animal products takes place in the context of an approved or authorised facility under the supervision of or directly by an authorised veterinarian, who may also be an Official Veterinarian (OV). However, where the authorised veterinarian is not an OV, then the certificate must be countersigned by an OV.

Please note: the certificate has only been agreed for the export of rhino occytes for an established scientific purpose. Importers must confirm the import conditions with the Italian authorities prior to using this certificate.

2. CERTIFICATION

The basic principles of certification apply. Although this is not an EU level harmonised EU entry certificate, the general requirements that the EU specifies for certification in context of harmonised certificates should be followed.
