FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: FOOTBALL RELATED CRIME/MALICIOUS COMMUNICATIONS ONLINE.

We refer to your email dated 1 April 2021 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on 6 April 2021.

In your email you requested the following information:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 I would like to request the following information from you:

- How many reports have you received of football-related hate crime and/or malicious communications online since 1 January 2021? For the avoidance of doubt, I am looking for reports of abuse levelled at a footballer.
- How many active investigations do you have into football-related hate crime/malicious communications online as of today, 1st April 2021? For the avoidance of doubt, I am looking for investigations being carried out by your police force into, for example, abuse levelled at a footballer.
- How many arrests have been made by your police force in relation to football related hate crime/malicious communications online in the last 3 years (broken down by year: 2019, 2020 and so far in 2021)?

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
