## **JUDGMENT**

### The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed. This means that the complaint of unfair dismissal was successful.
- 2. The claimant was dismissed without notice of payment of notice pay being given by the respondent.
- 3. The respondent failed to provide the claimant with written reasons for dismissal.
- 4. The respondent failed to provide a written statement of employment particulars to the claimant.
- The respondent failed to pay the claimant upon her dismissal, the unpaid holiday pay of 1 week which she had accrued at the date of termination of employment.

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6. The respondent failed to pay the claimant upon her dismissal, the accrued wages relating incentives of £200 which were unpaid at the date of termination of employment.

7. The case will now proceed to a remedy hearing which will take place on 2 **December 2021** in the **Liverpool Employment Tribunal** before Employment Judge Johnson and which is listed for 1 day.
