JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is:

- 1. The claimant's claims of disability discrimination were presented out of time in circumstances when it would not be just and equitable to extend time to the date of presentation of her claims. The Tribunal has no jurisdiction to consider the claims; they are therefore dismissed.
- 2. If the Tribunal had jurisdiction, the claimant's claims of direct discrimination, discrimination arising from disability and a failure to make reasonable adjustments would have been dismissed as they are not well-founded and they would have failed. The Tribunal found, in the alternative to paragraph 1 above, that the respondent did not discriminate against the claimant as alleged in relation to, or because of, the protected characteristic of disability.
