JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:

1. The Claimant's claim for notice pay is not well-founded and is dismissed.
2. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay is well-founded. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £665.00 holiday pay. This is a net award and the Respondent shall be liable to the Inland Revenue for any tax and national insurance payments thereon.
3. The Respondent's title is amended to Halabja Limited trading as Istanbul Pizza and service is deemed to have been effected.
