Thank you for your email of 28 October 2021 requesting the following information:

"Would it be possible to view the Service history for Land Rover Defender 110 XD Wolf, Service Reg MV33AA . I recently purchased the vehicle and I am keen to know were it's been and which Units it served with. I'm not sure how much information is available, but it had a recon engine fitted in 2017 and I like to know how many miles it's done since then if possible (for a true record of the mileage). Please could I have the vehicles unit transfer history for the JAMES system. I have already pre checked the ERM against the Merlin archive and the MOD Merlin release on the website."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence. I regret that no information is held on the JAMES system regarding the registration that you have provided.
