JUDGMENT

In claim 2203220/2019 (the Claimant's Fourth Claim) allegation 8.5 is struck out as against the Third Respondent and allegation 8.8 is struck out as against the First Respondent, for non-payment of the deposit orders made by EJ Walker at earlier hearings.

In claim 2203545/2019 (the Claimant's Fifth Claim) allegations 8.9, 8.10, 8.11, 8.13, 8.15 and 8.16 are struck out against the Fourth Respondent for non-payment of deposit orders.

In claim 2200135/2020 (the Claimant's Sixth Claim), the complaints of detriment at subparagraphs 9 (a) to (g) inclusive are struck out because

- (i) they were presented out of time and the Claimant stands no reasonable prospect of showing why time should be extended and
- (ii) the complaints were an abuse of process,

pursuant to Rule 37(1)(a) (Schedule 1, Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013).
