We refer to your email dated 5 May 2021 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same date.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

**1) The number of non-crime hate incidents recorded in your constabulary in each calendar month from 1st January 2018 to 5th May 2021 inclusive, broken down by calendar month (ie. a single number for January 2018, a single number for February 2018 etc).**

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
