## Dear

Thank you for your email of 20 September 2021 requesting the following information:

- 1. How many Afghans were called to Kabul Airport for evacuation under the Afghan Relocations and Assistance Policy but were not evacuated before the August 31 deadline;
- 2. The number of these aforementioned refugees whom the Ministry of Defence has supported to move to a third country;
- 3. The number of refugees referenced in question two who have subsequently arrived in the UK.

We are treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). Please accept our apologies for the delay in responding to you.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

The available information can be found below:

How many Afghans were called to Kabul Airport for evacuation under the Afghan Relocations and Assistance Policy but were not evacuated before the August 31 deadline;

The number of these aforementioned refugees whom the Ministry of Defence has supported to move to a third country;

The number of refugees referenced in question two who have subsequently arrived in the UK.

Of the 331, 85 have subsequently arrived in the UK.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
