JUDGMENT

- 1. The following of the claimant's claims are dismissed because the claimant has withdrawn them:
 - 1.1. Breach of contract,
 - 1.2. Victimisation,
 - 1.3. Unauthorised deduction from wages.
- 2. The following further claims are dismissed:
 - 2.1. Direct discrimination because of disability;
 - 2.2. Indirect discrimination because of disability;
 - 2.3. Failure to make reasonable adjustments;
 - 2.4. Discrimination arising from a disability;
 - 2.5. Harassment related to a disability.
- 3. Any future hearings are vacated and so will not take place.
