
OISC Regulation & Solicitors Flowchart



^{*} Solicitors who provide immigration advice and/or services only in an 'in house' capacity with an organisation, providing no immigration advice and services to the public, do not need to be regulated by the OISC. If the organisation also provides no immigration advice and/or services to the public, it also does not need to seek regulation from the OISC as an organisation.

^{**} A service operated by an organisation such as a charity or similar type of organisation that is operating otherwise than with a view for profit. It may or may not charge fees but if it does so then they must be paid to the organisation for furthering the provision of the organisation's services.
