JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated **10 December 2021** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because, as alleged by the Respondent's representatives' emails of 28 November 2021 and 8 December 2021 (which were copied to the Claimant)
 - the claimant had not complied with the Orders of the Tribunal dated **9 February 2021**.
 - The claim has not been actively pursued.
2. By the deadline of 11am on the 13 December 2021, the claimant has failed to make representations in writing and has failed to ask for a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out.
3. The hearing fixed for **15 December to 17 December 2021** will not take place.
