Thank you for your email received by the Ministry Of Defence on 19 October 2021 requesting the following information:

"...enquire about the estimated number of children there are at present with at least one parent serving in the British Armed Forces, in the UK or overseas."

We are treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

We have now completed a search for the information you requested, and can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

As at 1 April 2021, there were 105,330¹ children with at least 1 parent serving in the UK Regular Forces². Of these, 91,000¹ were aged under eighteen years old, while 14,330¹ were aged eighteen years old or over.

In line with JSP 200 on statistical disclosure, suppression methodology has been applied to ensure individuals are not inadvertently identified dependent on the risk of disclosure. Therefore, figures have been rounded to the nearest 10, though numbers ending in a "5" have been rounded to the nearest multiple of 20 to prevent the systematic bias caused by always rounding numbers upwards.

Notes:

- The figure is an estimate because the 'children' field of the Joint Personnel Administration (JPA) database from which the data has been sourced has not been validated. It is a field that Service Personnel fill in themselves. Figures will also include some double counting where two Service Personnel have had children together and both declared them on JPA.
- UK Regular Forces comprise Full time Service personnel, including Nursing Services, but excluding Full Time Reserve Service (FTRS) personnel, Gurkhas, mobilised Reservists, Military Provost Guard Service (MPGS), Locally Engaged Personnel (LEP), Non Regular Permanent Staff (NRPS), High Readiness Reserve (HRR) and Expeditionary Forces Institute (EFI) personnel. Includes trained and untrained personnel.
