## EXPORT TO CROATIA OF RABBITS FOR RESEARCH NOTES FOR GUIDANCE (NFG) FOR OFFICIAL VETERINARIANS AND **EXPORTERS**

This document should not be read as a standalone document but in conjunction with 9033EHC.

## SCOPE OF THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be used for the export of rabbits for research where the certification takes place in Wales, Scotlandor England, i.e. in Great Britain.

## CERTIFICATION

Although this is not an EU level harmonised EU entry certificate, the general requirements that the EU specifies for certification in context of harmonised certificates should be followed.

Date and time of arrival: an estimated date and time should be provided.

Means of transport: means of transport should be provided along with identification, eq. vessel name/flight number.

**Description of consignment:** cross through genotype/stock No/Number, as required.

## Health Attestation

The colony the animals have been supplied from must be free from the following pathogens:

Rabbit haemorrhagic disease virus Rabbit pox virus (myxomatosis) Rabbit rotavirus Bordetella bronchiseptica Clostridium piliforme Dermatophytes Treponema (paraluis) cuniculi Chilomastix sp. Cryptosporidium Eimeria sp.

Entamoeba sp.

Giardia spp.

Trichomonas sp.

This may be certified on the basis of supporting evidence from the veterinarian supervising the premises of origin together with the health monitoring programme applied to the premises.

The health monitoring programme must include the pathogens listed.
