## **JUDGMENT**

The Respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages. The Respondent is Ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £65.00, the gross amount of the unlawful deduction.

The Claim for damages for breach of contract succeeds. The Respondent is Ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £375, the gross sum due by way of damages in respect of that breach of contract.

The Respondent failed to give the Claimant a written statement of employment particulars and awards an amount equal to two weeks' pay. The Respondent is Ordered to pay the Claimant £750 in respect of that failure.

The claim in respect of holiday pay is dismissed on withdrawal.

The total the Respondent is Ordered to pay the Claimant is £1,190.00.
