Thank you for your correspondence of 22 May requesting the following information:

How many Air Traffic Controllers in the Royal Air Force applied for Flexible Service in the first round of Applications 1-5 Apr 19.

How many of these applications were approved?

How many of the approved applications were for people in actual air traffic controlling jobs (and not covering admin based jobs) ?

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

The number of Air Traffic Controllers (Officers and Airmen) who have applied for Flexible Service in the first round of applications 1-5 April 2019 is fewer than five. Of those applications none were approved.

In accordance with the Data Protection Act and our obligations in relation to the protection of confidentiality when handling personal data, data have been rounded.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact us in the first instance at the address above. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance tea, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail <u>CIO FOI IR@mod.uk</u>). Please note that any reason for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal process has been completed.
