Thank you for your e-mail of the 19 February 2021 requesting the following information:

"RAF GAI 1033 lists the entitlement of free-issue clothing to officers on first appointment and the mandatory items which are to be purchased from their initial outfitting allowances at the appropriate stages of service."

Please can you provide a full copy of the above and:

"JSP 886 Vol 6 Part 5, details the following scales:

- a. Scale C704 – C705 – lists entitlement to initial free-issue clothing for ATC Male and Female commissioned ranks.
- b. Scale C706 – C707– lists entitlement to free-issue clothing for Warrant Officers (ATC) and SNCO (ATC).
- c. Scale C708 – lists entitlement to free-issue clothing to ACO Civilian Instructors – Male/Female.
- d. Scale C709 – C710 – lists entitlement to free-issue clothing to ATC Male and Female Cadets.
- e. Scale C711 – lists entitlement to initial free-issue to officers and free-issue to Warrant Officers (ATC) of SATTs.
- f. Scale C712 – C713 – lists entitlement to initial free-issue clothing to CCF (RAF) Male and Female commissioned ranks.
- g. Scale C714 – C715–lists entitlement to free-issue clothing to CCF (RAF) Male and Female School Staff Instructors.
- h. Scale C716 – C717 – lists entitlement to free-issue clothing to CCF(RAF) Male and Female Cadets.
- i. Scale C718 – lists entitlement to initial free-issue to officers and free-issue to Warrant Officers(ATC), SNCO(ATC)and Students of the ACO Junior Leaders Course."

GAI 1033 Uniform (Service Dress) and Outfit Allowances - Officers**General**

1. This GAI details the uniform clothing which officers are required to possess, and associated allowances to which some officers are entitled. These allowances, which will be effective from the date this GAI is published, include VAT at the current rate and may be liable to alteration owing to variations in prices or tax. Scales of entitlement to warm weather clothing and allowances are dealt with separately under GAI 1022. Retrospective adjustment to allowances including re-ranking will be effected automatically by JPA; consequently, claims are not required either from units or individuals. All queries should be directed to AIR A4 Commodities, Gladiator Block, RAF High Wycombe, HP14 4UE.

2. Most items of uniform clothing are available from Service sources; any allowance issued is provided to enable personnel to purchase those scaled items which cannot be obtained from the Service. Additional requirements such as the sewing on of badges, ribbons etc should be, where possible, pursued through the station tailoring contract.

3. Issues of scaled uniform items and associated allowances are made once only. Officers are expected to maintain all items of uniform at personal expense via the tax relief published annually through DINs. Most items may be obtained from Service sources on the pre-payment terms published annually in DINs.

Scales of entitlement and allowances on commissioning

4. Details of scaled items of uniform issued free on commissioning are contained in the RAF Clothing Scales (Kestrel Database).

5. Officers or cadets who fail to complete officer training or special re-entrant training, withdraw voluntarily from training or have their training terminated involuntarily, will be required to return those items of uniform, irrespective of whether the items were issued or purchased from an allowance (2). However, officers re-selected for training in another Branch may retain all items of uniform previously issued pending the outcome of the alternative professional training. Additional issues will not be permitted. Officers or cadets who choose to remain in the Service on a non-commissioned basis may retain all items of uniform other than those recorded below.

Notes:

1. Service Supply Authorities may sell these items to other officers.
2. Officers or Cadets who voluntarily withdraw from initial and/or professional training will be charged for any other items of clothing issued or purchased from allowances which cannot be returned, such as 'next to skin' items or those items not considered fit for reissue.
6. Deficiencies. Deficiencies are to be charged against individuals based on 50% of the vocabulary price plus departmental expenses, for items issued by the Service. The preferred method of payment is to be cash; however, exceptionally, recovery may be made via Form 1680A, authorising recovery from the final payment made or, in the case of enlistment to non-commissioned ranks, from the next payment made. In the event of any outstanding debit balance, an undertaking is to be given by the individual, in writing, that settlement will be made within two months of the date payment was requested.

Break in Commissioned Service (1)

7. Officers re-appointed to a commission less than one year after previous commissioned service in the RAF or Reserve Air Forces will not be entitled to either a free issue of uniform items or corresponding allowances, unless the existing scales differ from those used for the original issue, in which case the differences will be permissible.

8. Officers re-appointed to a commission one year or more but less than four years after previous commissioned service in the RAF or Reserve Air Forces will not be entitled to a free issue of uniform items or corresponding allowances, unless the existing scales differ from those used for the original issue, in which case the differences will be permissible. Such officers will, however be entitled to an allowance based on 50% of the cost of the scaled entitlement. These allowances have been calculated as follows:

9. Officers and civilians re-appointed to commissions four years or more after previous commissioned Service will be entitled to a free initial issue of uniform items and allowances in accordance with the appropriate scale. Officers who, having left the Service were required to return items of uniform will, in the event of being re-appointed to a commission, be entitled to a free initial issue of uniform items in accordance with the appropriate scale.

Notes:

1. Breaks in Service will be calculated from the day following the last day of previous Service to either the date of reporting again for full time Service or re-appointment to non-regular Service.

Voluntary Resignation of Commission (1) (2)

10. Officers, including officers of the Reserve Air Forces, who resign voluntarily or whose commissions are terminated as a result of voluntary withdrawal from professional training and/or unsuitability for transfer to another Branch, within three years of the appointment to a commission, will be required to refund the value, at the time of commissioning, of any items of uniform clothing issued free of charge (including Warm Weather Clothing) and allowances issued, in the following proportions:

Less than one year's commissioned Service. Full value, at the time of issue, of all items of uniform issued free of charge, and allowances paid.

One to two years commissioned Service. Two thirds of the value, at the time of issue, of all items of uniform issued free of charge, and two thirds of all allowances paid.

Two or three years commissioned Service. One third of the value, at the time of issue, of all items of uniform issued free of charge, and one third of all allowances paid.

Notes:

1. Officers who have completed more than three years commissioned Service will not be required to return any items of uniform or repay any associated allowances.
2. The cost of recoveries will be based on the vocabulary price plus departmental expenses.

Rejoining After Voluntary Resignation

11. Subject to the provisions of Paras 7 to 9, officers who rejoin the Service, and have made refunds under the provision of Para 10, will not be entitled to free issues of uniform items, but will be reimbursed either with the amount of the original refund, or the original refund plus the cost of any additional scaled items. Such payments will be limited to ensure that the sum of the amount of the original allowance retained, plus the reimbursement, does not exceed the full allowance appropriate to the existing scale of entitlement.

Officers Recalled for Permanent Service in a National Emergency

12. Officers recalled for permanent Service in a national emergency, four years or less from the end of their previous permanent commissioned Service, will not receive any allowance or free issue of uniform. When the interval exceeds four years, officers will be kitted to the appropriate scale.

Maintenance of Uniform - Reserve Air Forces

13. Officers of the Reserve Air Forces who attend for duty or training will be paid an allowance at the rate of £22.50 per year for men and £32.00 for women for the upkeep of their scaled uniform items. The allowance will be paid once only in any one year and payment is subject to the officer having fulfilled the attendance requirement. Payment will be in arrears from the date of commissioning, except that for officers of the Training Branch of the RAF Volunteer Reserve, who will continue to be entitled to the allowance from 1 April following their commissioning in the branch, payment will be made on the following 1 July and annually thereafter. Officers holding commissions concurrently in the Training Branch of the RAF Volunteer Reserve (RAFVR(T)) and in another branch of the Reserve Air Forces (the RAFR or RAuxAF) will receive an additional allowance of one half of the appropriate sum for service in that branch of the Reserve Air Forces, subject to their satisfying the attendance for training requirements. Payments are to be made through the relevant pay authority.

Allowance Paid on Change of Rank

14. The allowances shown below will be paid on change of rank, as indicated, to cover expenses incurred in alterations to No 1, No 2 and No 5 Dress Uniform. These allowances are paid automatically, directly into the officers' accounts. There is no requirement to claim.

Notes:

1. If substantive promotion occurs while acting rank is held, no further payment is admissible.
2. On promotion to the rank of Gp Capt or Air Cdre, hats appropriate to the rank to which promoted may be issued free of charge by the Unit Supply Source. Details of issues are to be recorded in the officer's F667.

Reserve Air Forces Officers

15. Officers of the Reserve Air Forces are entitled to a re-ranking allowance. Regular officers appointed in a rank different to their regular commission rank will also be entitled to an allowance. The allowances will be paid against itemised receipts for re-ranking alterations. Where possible, parent station tailoring facilities should be used. If a change of hat is necessary details are to be referred to AIR A4 Commodities through the Supply Authority of the parent unit.

Allowances for Special Appointments

16. Officers authorised within the terms of AP1358 (RAF Dress Regulations) Chapter 9 to wear aiguillettes, royal cyphers and devices appropriate to their appointment, are to make application to AIR A4 Commodities through their parent units. All issues will be authorised on LOAN TERMS and are to be recorded in the Officer's F667. On relinquishing the appointment, officers are to ensure that the aiguillettes, cyphers and devices are either returned or transferred in accordance with the requirements of AP1358 (Chapter 9). The officer's parent unit is to ensure that the officer's F667 is cleared and AIR A4 Commodities is advised of the action taken. The cost of alterations to No 1 and No 5 Dress Uniforms to receive the devices will be reimbursed by AIR A4 Commodities on production of an original itemised receipt. Similarly, reimbursement will be approved on the production of an original itemised receipt to cover alterations to return the

uniforms to standard state on completion of assignment. Unit Supply Authorities are to return all ceremonial items to RAF Northolt for maintenance in the ceremonial pool.

Full Ceremonial Evening Dress

17. Requests for No 5A Dress Uniform items are to be referred to AIR A4 Commodities through Supply Authority on the parent unit.

Honorary Chaplain to HM The Queen

18. On initial appointment as Honorary Chaplain to the Queen, Officers will be advised in writing from AIR A4 GC & GS that they are entitled to purchase a scarlet cassock, cincture band and badge. Itemised receipts should be forwarded to AIR A4 Commodities who will arrange reimbursement.
