Thank you for your request for information which was processed in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You requested the following information:

Please can you tell me:

- The amount of money Homes England has spent in total on purchasing land intended for development (or for resale and development) annually during the financial years 2019/20, 2020/21 and 2021/22 (to date)
- The number of plots owned by Homes England at the end of the financial years 2019/20, 2020/21 and 2021/22 (to date).

### **Response**

We can confirm that we do hold the requested information and will address each of your points in turn.

# The amount of money Homes England has spent in total on purchasing land intended for development (or for resale and development) annually during the financial years 2019/20, 2020/21 and 2021/22 (to date)

The table below shows the amount of money Homes England has spent in total on purchasing land intended for development. These figures reflect the departmental expenditure limit (DEL) capital expenditure on acquisition activity recorded for each financial year as requested. They include expenditure from all development budgets (Land Assembly Fund and Single Land Programme). We can advise that some of the money was spent on either new projects and stand-alone acquisitions, later phases of existing projects and also smaller fragments of land required for purposes such as access. These figures exclude Stamp Duty Land Tax.

We have interpreted this to mean the "number of remaining homes (housing completions) forecast on land where the freehold is owned by Homes England, and where the land is not already under an unconditional contract (e.g. building lease) with another party. We can advise that as projects would have been at various stages of delivery cycle, forecasted data would have been subject to change, particularly where planning consent for development has not yet been secured. Therefore, we are unable to provide more exact figures than the below.

You may also complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) however, the Information Commissioner does usually expect the internal review procedure to be exhausted in the first instance.
