

# Registering test kits for homecare workers

## How testing works

Complete a swab test on the same day each week between Thursday and Sunday. Make sure you conduct, register and post your test kit in your nearest Royal Mail Priority Postbox.

## To register test kits:

- 1 Go to [www.gov.uk/register-organisation-tests](https://www.gov.uk/register-organisation-tests)
- 2 Tick **both boxes** selecting 'I confirm that I'm authorised to register each person on behalf of my organisation' and 'I confirm that each person knows that their results will go to the contact details I enter as you are only inputting your own information you have consent.'

- 7 Enter your email address and phone number. Test results will be sent to the contact details inputted.
