1. The complaint that Ms S Douthwaite subjected the claimant to disability related harassment and thereby contravened the Equality Act 2010 by shouting at him.
2. The complaint that Ms R Douthwaite and/or Ms Bradshaw victimised the claimant and thereby contravened the Equality Act 2010 by saying, "You are only doing this because your father passed away".
3. The complaint that the respondent contravened the Equality Act 2010 by dismissing the claimant in December 2020.
