# Re: S31 Grant Determination Letter for Skills Advisory Panels: Producing high quality analysis and maintaining local relationships (No 31/5591) and DfE reference 4709)

This Determination is made between:

- 1. The Secretary of State for Education, and
- 2. The Local Authorities or Mayoral Combined Authorities (MCAs) on behalf of the local area(s) covered by the MCAs and Local Enterprise Partnerships (LEPs) listed in Annex A

I am pleased to inform you that the Department for Education (DfE) is willing to offer your organisation funding of £75,000 for your Skills Advisory Panel (SAP) to maintain analysis of local labour markets and relationships to support local skills planning whilst we trial Local Skills Improvement Plans (LSIPs) in trailblazer areas. The central aims of the Grant funding are to:

- A. Continue to produce high quality local-level skills analysis (aligned with the standards set out in the <u>SAPs' Analytical Toolkit</u>) to reflect changes in local labour markets impacted by the pandemic.
- B. Maintain relationships to deliver the local skills agenda. In addition, SAPs in Trailblazer areas (once identified) will support the employer representative body developing the LSIP by sharing their analysis and intelligence on the local labour market and encouraging their stakeholders to work collaboratively in support of the development of the LSIP.
- C. Refresh and publish Local Skills Report between 30 November 2021 and 28 January 2022. This specific requirement may be removed/amended if the SAP has been identified in a Trailblazer area. In this scenario, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that accompanies this Grant Determination Letter will be reviewed by DfE on a case-by-case basis to

determine if/how any relevant funding for this aim should be reallocated to activities undertaken by the SAP to support the employer representative body in the development of the LSIP, or for activities that support objectives A or B (as set out above).

Further details on the objectives and principles for the use of funding and the respective responsibilities of each participant are set out in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which has been reached between both parties.

You are asked to provide a use of funds statement confirming that the grant was received and was spent wholly on the purposes for which it was given, at the end of financial year 2021-22 (i.e. in April 2022), signed by your Accounting Officer.

# **GRANT DETERMINATION 2021/22: Skills Advisory Panels:** Producing high quality analysis and maintaining local relationships

The Secretary of State for Education, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, makes the following determination:

#### <u>Citation</u>

1) This determination may be cited as the "Skills Advisory Panels: Producing high quality analysis and maintaining local relationships" Grant Determination 2021/22 (No31/5591).

#### Purpose of the grant

2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to Local Authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

#### **Determination**

3) The Secretary of State for Education determines the Authorities to which the Grant is to be paid and the amount of Grant to be paid; these are set out in Annex A.

#### Payment of Grant

4) The Grants shall be payable to Local Authorities in one instalment no earlier than June 2021 for 2021/2022.
