#### 1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 - 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland'. The accounts have been prepared using the historical cost convention except where disclosed that certain items are shown at fair value.

The financial statements are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the entity. Monetary amounts are rounded to the nearest £.

#### Judgements and key sources of estimation uncertainty

The union consider that there were no estimates and assumptions which have a significant risk of causing a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities.

#### Income

Membership subscription income is recognised on a receivable basis.

#### **Expenditure**

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the union to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. All expenditure is inclusive of VAT where applicable.

#### Taxation

Corporation tax is payable on all interest income and other investment income to the extent they exceed expenditure on provident benefits.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Tangible fixed assets are initially measured at cost and subsequently measured at cost less depreciation and any impairment losses.

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Motor vehicles - 25% reducing balance

#### Cash and cash equivalents

Cash is represented by cash in hand and bank deposits.

#### **Debtors**

Short term debtors are measured at transaction price, less any impairment.

#### **Creditors**

Short term creditors are measured at the transaction price.

#### **Financial instruments**

The union only enters into basic financial instruments transactions that result in the recognition of financial assets and liabilities like trade and other debtors and creditors, loans from banks and other third parties and loans to related parties. Basic financial instruments are initially measured at transaction price and subsequently carried at amortised cost.
