## **JUDGMENT**

- The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is that the claimant was not dismissed by the first respondent so that her claim that she had been thereby unlawfully discriminated against fails
- The majority judgment of the tribunal is that the second respondent indicated to the claimant on 5 November 2019 that the first respondent "needed people out there that are sharp"
- The majority judgment of the tribunal is that the respondents thereby harassed the claimant and treated her unfavourably because of something arising from disability
- The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is that the claimant is awarded £2,500 to represent injury to feelings, together with interest thereon of £467.50 against the first respondent
- The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is that the first respondent failed to provide the claimant with a statement of principal terms of employment and is directed to pay the claimant £962.
