Air Quality and Dust Monitoring Monthly Report - October 2021

West Northamptonshire District Council



High Speed Two (HS2) Limited has been tasked by the Department for Transport (DfT) with managing the delivery of a new national high speed rail network. It is a non-departmental public body wholly owned by the DfT.

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Monthly Summary

- 1.1.1 This Summary Report is published in fulfilment of commitments detailed in the High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Environmental Minimum Requirements, Annex 1: Code of Construction Practice, for the nominated undertaker to present the results of dust monitoring undertaken in the West Northamptonshire District Council (WNDC) area during October 2021.
- 1.1.2 Figure 1 to Figure 2 in Appendix A indicate the current worksites together with air quality and dust monitoring locations.
- 1.1.3 This summary should be read in conjunction with the overview monitoring report available from www.gov.uk/government/collections/monitoring-the-environmental-effects-of-hs2, which highlights: the applicable standards and guidance, as well as the air quality and dust monitoring methodologies to be implemented by nominated undertakers throughout construction.
- 1.1.4 The current phase of works commenced in May 2021 and is expected to be completed by 2025. The current worksites, as presented in Appendix A, Figure 1 to Figure 2 include:

Greatworth to Southam (G2S)

- Excavation for chipping warden green tunnel;
- De-vegetation works;
- Drainage and ponds construction;
- Topsoil stripping and material movement; and
- Establishment of the site access road.

Twyford to Greatworth (T2G)


- Topsoil stripping for Brackley South cutting;
- De-vegetation works and utilities diversion;
- Stockpiling;
- Drainage and ponds construction; and
- Development of A43 Compound.
- 1.1.5 Four (4) dust monitors are installed around worksites, where works are underway. These sites returned a medium dust risk rating.
- 1.1.6 Dust monitoring locations and results are presented in Appendix B, Table 1, together with a line chart of monthly data from the dust monitor presented in Figure 3. All continuous dust monitoring is undertaken using indicative monitors. Despite being Environment Agency (MCERTS) certified, indicative monitors carry a higher level of uncertainty than reference monitors, and therefore cannot be strictly compared with Air Quality Standards for human health and the environment. The purpose of the monitoring undertaken is to ensure the effectiveness of the on-site mitigation.


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- 1.1.7 The trigger level for PM₁₀ concentrations of 190 μg/m³, over a 1-hour period, in accordance with the updated guidance document 'Guidance on Monitoring in the Vicinity of Demolition and Construction Sites (October 2018)' has been applied.
- 1.1.8 No dust trigger alerts were recorded during the monitoring period (October 2021).
- 1.1.9 Data capture was below 90% for multiple monitors in October 2021 due to power supply issues.
- 1.1.10 There were no (0) complaints received during this reporting period.
