## Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier wild pollinator and farm wildlife calculator: Pastoral

Use this calculator to help build a wild pollinator and farm wildlife package as part of a Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier application.

## How to use:

Step 1: complete section 1. The area of eligible land entered into the application-and subject to the Wild Pollinator and Farm Wildlife Package (WPFWP) - is made up of:

1) BPS declared arable land,
2) temporary grassland, and
3) permanent grassland.

All other land should be excluded from the calculation.
Step 2: complete sections 2 to 4 by selecting those options that are best suited to your farm enterprise, crop rotation and soil type. Look at the individual option requirements on www.gov.uk/countryside-stewardship-grants to make sure that they can be delivered. Each table will indicate the target area of habitat required to pass the minimum threshold. You only need to enter the proposed area(s) of each option into the blue cells.
Step 3: go to section 5 and select any additional options listed in the chosen package, where these can be realistically included in the application. These options will enhance the environmental benefits that can be provided through an agreement, and will increase the score of the application. It will also increase the financial value of the agreement, should the application be successful. As per step 2 you only need to enter areas into the blue cells.
Step 4: double-check all of the calculations in sections 2 to 5 to make sure the minimum package requirements have been met. Sections 6 and 7 provide a summary of how the application performs against the minimum and maximum requirements for the package. Section 8 provides a summary of the annual payments accruing from delivering the package.
