JUDGMENT

The response is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds:

- that the response has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. The Employment Tribunal wrote to the respondent on 31st December 2018, after their agent had withdrawn from acting, asking if they intended to appoint another representative. No response was received.
2. The Employment Tribunal wrote again to the respondent asking them to reply by 17th January 2019. No response was received.
3. On 23rd January 2019 the Tribunal gave the respondent an opportunity to give written reasons by 6th February 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the response should not be struck out.
4. The respondent has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the response.
