<b>Risk Description</b>	The product presents a serious risk of injuries as testing found that the fasteners that attach the shoulders to the body of the product unstitch after 5 cycles of use and the product breaks. This poses an injuries hazard to babies/young children as the safety straps may detach while the product is in use, causing the baby/young child to fall on the floor. The product does not meet the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulations 2005.
