JUDGMENT

Each claimant's claims against the First Respondent are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By orders sent to the parties in writing on 23 February 2021 (following a hearing 4 and 5 January 2021), the Claimants were notified that the claims against the First Respondent, a dissolved company, could not proceed unless that company was restored to the register. The Claimants were told that they must write to the tribunal by 30 June 2021 to confirm that that had been done, or else to give reasons as to why the claims should not be struck out.
- 2. No responses having been received, a reminder was sent to each claimant by emails dated 28 September 2021. The second and third claimant each replied to the reminder emails, but without stating that any actions to restore the First Respondent to the register had been taken.
- 3. By letter dated 15 November 2021, the claimants were given an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because it has not been actively pursued.
- 4. No claimant has made representations in writing or asked for a hearing. Each claim against the First Respondent is therefore struck out.
