JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 - Rule 21

- 1. The Respondent's title is amended to Inn Trade Solutions Limited
- 2. The Claimant's claim for the unauthorised deduction of wages, pursuant to section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996, is well-founded.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for accrued and outstanding holiday pay, pursuant to Regulation 14 of the Working Time Regulations 1998, is well-founded.

REASONS

- 1. The Claimant submitted her ET1 form to the Employment Tribunal on 23 November 2021. A copy of the claim form was forwarded to the Respondent by the Tribunal on 30 November 2021 and the Respondent had until 28 December 2021 to file a response.
- 2. As no response was received by the Tribunal from the Respondent, the above Judgment has been entered without a hearing on the basis of the information provided by the Claimant and in accordance with Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013.
- 3. The unauthorised deduction of wages claim relates to 10 days' unpaid wages for the holidays taken by the Claimant from 13 September 2021 to 24 September 2021.
- 4. The accrued holiday pay claim shall be quantified at the remedy hearing.
