JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The Respondent's title is amended to Inn Trade Solutions Limited
2. The Claimant's claim for the unauthorised deduction of wages, pursuant to section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996, is well-founded.
3. The Claimant's claim for accrued and outstanding holiday pay, pursuant to Regulation 14 of the Working Time Regulations 1998, is well-founded.

REASONS

1. The Claimant submitted her ET1 form to the Employment Tribunal on 23 November 2021. A copy of the claim form was forwarded to the Respondent by the Tribunal on 30 November 2021 and the Respondent had until 28 December 2021 to file a response.
2. As no response was received by the Tribunal from the Respondent, the above Judgment has been entered without a hearing on the basis of the information provided by the Claimant and in accordance with Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013.
3. The unauthorised deduction of wages claim relates to 10 days' unpaid wages for the holidays taken by the Claimant from 13 September 2021 to 24 September 2021.
4. The accrued holiday pay claim shall be quantified at the remedy hearing.
