I, the undersigned, certify that:

- a) On \_\_\_\_\_ (date), being not more than 72 hours prior to the date of export, the said animal was examined and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease and in my opinion is fit to travel;
- b) The said animal has been identified with an implanted microchip transponder, details of which have been given at paragraph I. above;
- c) A written declaration has been received from the owner/exporter\* stating that the said animal has been resident in the United Kingdom during the previous six months; or since birth; or undergone a full six months quarantine in the UK; or come from a third country participating in the PETS scheme and carries a valid PETS passport (in which case the passport must be sighted and accompany this certificate).
- d) The United Kingdom is officially free of rabies according to the rules of the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE), Terrestrial Animal Health Code;

(ii) On (date), being within 30 days prior to the date of export, a blood sample was taken from the said animal and sent to a government approved laboratory and subjected to the PCR test for Feline Leukaemia Virus, with a negative result. **NB:** Only cats giving a negative result to this test will be allowed entry into the Falkland Islands;

(iii) On (date), being within 30 days prior to the date of export, a blood sample was taken from the said animal and sent to a government approved laboratory and subjected to the 'Coronavirus Ab test' for **Feline Infectious Peritonitis** (coronavirus), with a negative result;

(iv) On (date), being not more than 72 hours prior to export, the cat was treated with Praziquantal at a dose rate of 5mg per kg bodyweight and Pyrantel at a dose rate of 57.5mg per kg bodyweight using the product according to the manufacturer's instructions:
