I, the undersigned, certify that:

A written declaration has been received from the owner/exporter\* stating that the said animal has been resident in the United Kingdom during the previous six months; or since birth; or undergone a full six months quarantine in the UK; or come from a third country participating in the PETS scheme and carries a valid PETS passport (in which case the passport must be sighted and accompany this certificate).

d) The United Kingdom is officially free of rabies according to the rules of the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE), Terrestrial Animal Health Code;

- (iii) On (date), being within 30 days prior to the date of export, a blood sample was taken from the said animal and sent to a government approved laboratory and subjected to the 'Coronavirus Ab test' for Feline Infectious Peritonitis (coronavirus), with a negative result;
- (iv) On (date), being not more than 72 hours prior to export, the cat was treated with Praziquantal at a dose rate of 5mg per kg bodyweight and Pyrantel at a dose rate of 57.5mg per kg bodyweight using the product according to the manufacturer's instructions:
