PRELIMINARY HEARING JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is:

- 1. C1's claim of entitlement to a redundancy payment is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- The claimants' applications to amend their claims to include claims of Unfair Dismissal based on the principle of Hogg v Dover College [1990] ICR 39 are refused and dismissed.
- 3. C1's unamended claim is dismissed as the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear it.
- 4. The applications made by C2 and C3 to amend their claims to include claims of constructive unfair dismissal are granted.
- 5. Pursuant to the above, further Orders were made which are set out in a separate document.
