I am writing following the intervention assessment of Kingston Maurward College by the Further Education (FE) Commissioner on 22 November 2021, which took place following a period of support from the FE Commissioner team via diagnostic assessment and follow-up visits in 2020 and 2021.

From the FE Commissioner's report, it is clear that the college faces a number of financial risks. I have accepted all the recommendations of the FE Commissioner and I urge the college to implement them, including engaging with the team for a Structure and Prospects Appraisal and continuing to work closely with the Education and Skills Funding Agency.
