JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds:

• that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. On 21 October 2021, the claimant was asked to confirm that he received the maximum amount which the insurance fund can pay and, if so, that he would withdraw the claim.

No reply was received.

2 On 3 November 2021, the Tribunal issued a reminder to the claimant that he should provide a response to the Tribunal's letter within seven days.

No reply was received.

- On 12 November 2021 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 26 November 2021 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
