JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim (or the part struck out) has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

- By email of 17 December 2020 the claimant's representative advised that this claim was continuing and that a schedule of loss and other documents would be submitted to the Tribunal in due course. No schedule or documentation were lodged.
- 2. On 11 June 2021 the Tribunal wrote seeking an update on the claim. No reply was received.
- 3. The Tribunal issued a reminder on 12 July 2021. No reply was received.
- 4. On 2 August 2021 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written

reasons by 16 August 2021 or to request a hearing in order to consider why claim should not be struck out.

5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
