JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

1. The Tribunal has received no communication from the claimant in this case. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 7 April 2021, 5 May 2021 and 27 May 2021 to which no reply has been received.

- On 9 June 2021 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to respond or give reasons why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
