JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

1. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 11 May 2021 asking him to confirm within 14 days what claim(s) he considered the Tribunal to have jurisdiction to determine. No reply was received to that letter.
2. On 9 June 2021 the Tribunal issued a reminder to the claimant. No reply was received to that letter.
3. On 22 June 2021 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 7 July 2021 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.

4. The claimant has failed to reply at all and has therefore failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
