JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds of non compliance with Orders of the Tribunal dated 21 February 2020 in terms of rule 37(1)(c); and that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

The claimant presented an application to the Employment Tribunal on 24 October 2019. A preliminary hearing was fixed for 21 February 2020. The claimant failed to attend the preliminary hearing and failed to notify the Tribunal in advance that she would not be attending. Following the hearing, orders were issued by the Tribunal to be complied with by the claimant by 13 March 2020. The claimant failed to comply with the orders.

- On 8 June 2020, the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 22 June 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
