## **JUDGMENT**

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- i. The claimant lodged a claim in the Employment Tribunal on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2019 seeking arrears of pay. No reply was received from the claimant to the Tribunal's correspondence dated 8<sup>th</sup> January 2020.
- ii. On 27<sup>th</sup> July 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out because the claim has not been actively pursued.
- iii. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
