JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

1. The Employment Tribunal wrote to the claimant asking him to provide details of his position on 14 August 2020. No response was received. A reminder letter was sent to him on 30 September 2020. No response was received.
2. On 24 October 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 9 November 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
