I, the undersigned, hereby certify that:

- 1. Where products contain poultry meat or their derivatives, the products have been sufficiently heat treated to destroy the Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza and Newcastle disease viruses and the necessary precautions were taken after processing to avoid contact of the commodity with any source of HPAI or Newcastle disease viruses;

- 2. Where the product contains pork meat,
Either:
 - a) *The pork meat used in the manufacture of the pet food originated in (country) which is officially recognized as free from African Swine Fever

 - b) *the pork meat used in the manufacture of the pet food was heat treated for at least 30 minutes at a minimum core temperature of at least 70°C

c) *the pork meat used in the manufacture of the pet food was cured with salt and dried for a minimum of six months

3. the beef, beef products and/or bovine meal ingredients contained in the products certified herein originated from the United Kingdom or were legally imported with respect to bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE);
4. the raw animal material used in the manufacture of the petfood is low risk material obtained from healthy slaughtered animals, the meat from which has been passed as fit for human consumption;
5. in the case of petfood in hermetically sealed containers, the petfood has been heat treated to a Fo value of 3.000 or more;
6. in the case of dried or semi-moist petfood:
 - (a) the animal material used in the manufacture of the petfood has been heat treated so as to achieve a temperature throughout its substance of at least 90°C;
 - (b) after processing, every precaution was taken to ensure that the consignment was not contaminated in any way prior to shipment;
 - (c) the petfood was packed in new containers;
 - (d) the production process has been tested, with satisfactory results, for the presence of salmonellae and enterobacteriaceae.
