DECISION OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

The hearing is adjourned and will be rescheduled.

REASONS

35

1. A hearing was scheduled to take place in this case on Tuesday 8 May 2018 at 10.00am.
2. The claimant did not appear to represent herself at the hearing.
3. She was contacted by the clerk to ascertain the reason for her non-attendance, and the claimant advised that she had e-mailed the Tribunal the
ETZ4(WR)

previous day (a bank holiday) to advise that she was unable to attend as her daughter is not in nursery today, and that she was not aware of the time of the hearing.

4. It transpired that the claimant had sent several e-mails on 7 and 8 May seeking confirmation of the time of the hearing, and advising that her daughter was not able to attend nursery because she has scarlet fever.
5. In these circumstances, I adjourned the hearing, and direct that this case should be re-listed for a fresh hearing.
6. Miss Holland will be notified in due course of the date and time of the new hearing. She is required to be present at that hearing, as any failure to attend the hearing without reasonable excuse may result in the claim being dismissed.
